1. Learned counsel for the respondents refers to an order dated 12.07.2024, to contend that the petitioner has been granted the benefit of regularization to the post of Group-D (Shramik) and the consequential benefits arising therefrom shall be released in his favour within a period of 04 weeks from today.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
