1. The present petition under Section 483 read with Section 528 BNSS, 2023 has been filed for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in FIR No.346 dated 18.09.2023 under Section 306 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala w.e.f. 24.10.2024 to 30.10.2024 to attend bhog ceremony of his father as well as to be with family.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is facing trial in aforesaid FIR No.346 dated 18.09.2023. He submits that the father of the petitioner has expired on 19.10.2024. Thereafter, the petitioner was permitted to perform the last rites of his father vide order dated 21.10.2024 passed by the trial Court (Annexure P-5). He further submits that the petitioner is seeking interim bail to attend bhog ceremony of his father as well as to be with family.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amrik Singh Narwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel has submitted photocopy of the report dated 25.10.2024 of SHO, Police Station Mullana in vernacular, received through whatsapp, which is taken on record. While referring to the said report, learned State counsel has confirmed the aforesaid facts.
5. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of 5 days w.e.f. 26.10.2024 to 30.10.2024, subject to his furnishing adequate bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner will surrender before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on 31.10.2024.
6. The petition stands disposed of.
