Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside/waive off (compensation amount of Rs.21,50,000/- in total five criminal complaints as well as in default of rigorous imprisonment of sentence of 15 months in five criminal complaints) the orders dated 04.09.2019 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) and order dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) and 07.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned JMIC, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari vide which the petitioner has been burdened with payment of compensation amount as imposed by the Court while convicting the petitioner in five complaint cases.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the grounds before the Appellate Court by way of filing appeal.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
