1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 04.08.2023 passed in CWP-16830-2023.
2. Mr. T.S.Sidhu, Advocate, puts in appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.3, which is taken on record.
