AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Sandeep Kumar has filed this petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of impugned order dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur whereby bail order of petitioner was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State and further quashing of order dated 04.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) whereby proceedings were initiated under Section 83 of Cr.P.C. in complaint titled as “Bharat Singla versus Sandeep Kumar” under Section 138/142 of Negotiable Instruments Act.
2. On the previous date i.e. 29.10.2024, petitioner was directed to surrender before learned trial Court/Duty Judge and was given relief of interim bail.
3. Today, learned counsel for petitioner has placed on record

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downloaded copies of orders dated 29.10.2024 and 03.11.2024 vide which present petitioner-Sandeep Kumar surrendered before learned trial Court and was released on bail. Now he is facing the trial.

4. Considering the aforesaid factual position, impugned order dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) and 04.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) are accordingly quashed and in terms of previous order dated 29.10.2024, interim bail already granted in favour of petitioner stands confirmed.

5. Petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
