This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 19.04.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-9017-2021.

Reply by way of affidavit of Amneet Singh, DFO, Amritsar has been filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 19.04.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-9017-2021 has been complied with and necessary payments, including the interest thereon have been paid to the petitioner. Necessary document to this effect has also been annexed as Annexure R-7 along with the reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
