Main Case

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying of the order dated 27.07.2023 passed in CWP-15989-2023.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Siddarth Dahiya, Estate Officer, HSVP, Faridabad has been filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 27.07.2023 passed in CWP-15989-2023 has been complied with and vide letter dated 25.01.2024, the petitioner has been asked to take physical possession of Plot No.26, Sector 2, Palwal.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
