KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.27 dated 26.2.2024, under Sections 323, 341, 379-B (deleted later), 34 IPC under Sections 394, 397, 120-B, 411 IPC added lateron, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehegarh Sahib.
2. After addressing arguments for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned and to make an application for bail before that Court, and the same is directed to be decided most expeditiously.
3. Leave granted.

4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, however, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned within 15 days from today, and thereupon, if he makes an application before the latter concerned for grant of bail, the latter shall decide the same within two days, thereafter affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.
5. Pending application(s) stand disposed of accordingly.
