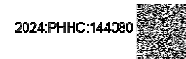

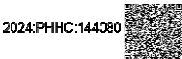

1. Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 11.01.2021 (Annexure P-19) passed by respondent No.3 vide which appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 05.05.2016 (Annexure P-5) and order dated 19.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) was dismissed and for quashing orders dated 05.05.2016 (Annexure P-5) 19.07.2017 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that apart from other grounds which have been taken in the present petition, one of the ground is that the appellate order dated 11.01.2021 is totally illegal, cryptic and non-speaking as the points taken in the appeal have not been considered by the appellate authority.

3. On receipt of advance copy of the petition, learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from the department, submits that



the impugned order dated 11.01.2021, passed by the appellate authority be treated as withdrawn and the matter shall be reconsidered by the appellate authority.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. Let the matter be reconsidered by the appellate authority, within a period of four months from today, and necessary orders be passed, after affording personal hearing to the petitioner.
