1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are entitled for the grant of minimum of the pay scale along with Dearness Allowance keeping in view the judgment of this Court passed in CWP No. 2225 of 2018 titled as *Satpal Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others*, decided on 27.08.2024, hence, respondents be directed to grant the said benefits to the petitioners as well.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 26.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 26.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority by keeping in mind the judgment in *Satpal Singh's case (supra)* within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
