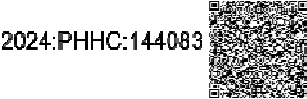

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 for taking action against respondents No. 3 to 5 for committing theft, cheating, fraud and forgery with the petitioner.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation on 02.07.2024 (*Annexure P-1*) before respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhinaa raising his grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He has further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.
3. Notice of motion.



4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice of the petition on behalf of the respondent-State and has submitted that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take appropriate action, if so required.
