1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondents to consider the petitioner as eligible for the post of Junior Engineer (Civil).
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the present petition has been filed on the ground that there was a mistake in filling up the roll number in the OMR Sheet. He further submitted that respondent No.2 has already filed the reply and in which it has been mentioned that otherwise also the numbers obtained by the petitioner were calculated and he has secured 55 marks whereas the last selected candidate has secured 57 marks and therefore in view of the result of the petitioner, nothing would survive in the present petition and the same may be dismissed.
3. In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is dismissed
