Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for directing respondents to pay the salary of the petitioners w.e.f 05.04.2024 up till date.

2. This Court on 18.12.2024 passed the following order:-

“Written statement dated 17.12.2024 on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the other side.

Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

It is not in dispute that presently, all the petitioners are working with respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, and if that is the position, their salaries be paid tomorrow by 11 A.M.

In case there is a failure, Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra shall present in person on the next date of hearing.

3. Compliance report by way of affidavit dated 19.12.2024 of Mr.

Varun Singla, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra on behalf of

respondents No. 1 to 4 has been filed and the same is taken on record.

4. For reference, para 3 and 4 of the same reads as under:-

“3. That, in compliance of the above mentioned order, the special sanction for releasing the salary of the present petitioners was sought from the office of the Director General of Police Haryana, Panchkula (Annexure P-4). That in response to the above letter, special sanction for the releasing the salary of petitioners along with other beneficiaries was obtained from the office of Director General of Police Haryana, Panchkula which is annexed as Annexure R-5.

4. Thereby, in compliance of the order of Hon’ble Court, the arrear of salary of the petitioners is hereby released and consequently transferred into their respective accounts. The detail of Pay Order as well as invoice is hereby attached as Annexure R-6 for kind perusal of the Hon’ble High Court.”

5. A perusal of the above extract reveals that grievance of the petitioners stand redressed by the respondents; therefore, this Court, really appreciates the efforts made by Sh. Varun Singla, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra.

6.. In view of the above development, learned counsel for petitioners submits that this petition be disposed off.

7. Ordered accordingly.

8. Needless to say that for the future, in order to avoid the litigation, petitioners be paid salaries well in time.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
