Prayer in the instant application is for advancing the date
of hearing of main case from 06.02.2025 to some early date.

Heard.

In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the
same is allowed and the date of hearing of the main case is advanced
from 06.02.2025 to today itself.

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1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated
19.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Trial Court, whereby his
bail order was cancelled and bail/surety bonds were forfeited in case
FIR No.36 dated 13.08.2018 under Section 379-B of the IPC (Sections
411, 201 and 34 of the IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station
Majitha Road, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that

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the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the learned Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the learned Trial Court, and directions be given to the Trial Court that his application of bail, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. However, this shall be subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority concerned, which shall be a condition precedent.
6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the Trial Court shall make earnest efforts to decide it expeditiously, in accordance with law.
