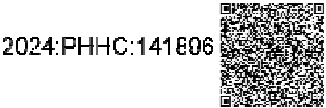

1. Instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent-Corporation not to effect recovery from the petitioners pending the decision of the application for stay made in the appeal dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners against the orders dated 08.10.2024/09.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 whereby recovery has been imposed upon the petitioners and ordered to be recovered from their salary in the ratio of 60:40. Further prayer has been made for direction to respondent No.1 to decide the application for stay made along with the appeal dated



23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner against orders dated 08.10.2024/09.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for deciding the appeal dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. M.S. Batth, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection if the time-bound directions are issued to the Appellate Authority to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

6. Respondent No.1-Appellate Authority is directed to decide the appeal dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further recovery from the petitioners shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the Appellate Authority.

8. Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
