SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

The petitioner in this Public Interest Litigation (PIL) has alleged certain corrupt activities of certain civil post holders under the State of Punjab. He has also alleged in-action on the part of respondent No.2 for not taking action against the erring officials/officers.

2. This Court is afraid that this PIL cannot be entertained, in view of alternative remedy available to the petitioner to approach Lokayukta, which is very much functional in State of Punjab. The petitioner is free to make a complaint before Lokayukta, Punjab, containing all allegations as alleged herein.

3. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
