At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners, as always, fairly submits that although, two separate civil suits filed by the parties, against each other, are pending consideration before the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gurugram, but dehors that, the authorities were served with the legal notice dated 15.04.2024 (P-23), as regards the other concerns/grievances the petitioners have. However, he submits that even though, a considerable time has elapsed, but the matter has not made any tangible progress.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, for the present, he be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioners to pursue the matter with the respondent authorities, in the first instance.

Served with the advance copy of the petition, Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, is present in Court. She submits that in the event, any such legal notice is pending



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with the authorities, the same shall be taken cognizance of. And, appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed, at the earliest.
