1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to re-issue the passport.
2. The learned counsel representing the respondents-Union of India, submits that FIR No.29, dated 24.01.2029, under Section 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 506 IPC, Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, has been registered against the petitioner which is pending in the Court and the Regional Passport Officer has sought report from the concerned Superintendent of Police, Karnal and the moment the report is received, an appropriate decision in accordance with law shall be taken.



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3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the Superintendent of Police, Karnal, is directed to forward the report to the concerned Regional Passport Officer, within three weeks from today and on receipt thereof, the Regional Passport Officer, shall take a final decision within one month thereafter.

4. Disposed of accordingly.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
