The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to clear the status of challan being shown against the vehicle of the petitioner bearing Registration No. PB-08-CY-2758, on the web site of Transport Department of Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) including reminder dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) to the respondent-authorities but no action has been taken by them till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Aditya Sharda, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents.



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Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.3-the Regional Transport Officer, Administrative Complex, Jalandhar is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) including reminder dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3-the Regional Transport Officer, Administrative Complex, Jalandhar to consider and decide the representation dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) including reminder dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of **two months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
