2. Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and exemption from filing the true typed/certified/photocopies of Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-8 is granted as prayed for.

3. Disposed of.

MAIN CASE

By way of present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action on the basis of complaints dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-7 and Annexure P-8) filed by the petitioner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner

that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of private respondents No.5 to 15, the petitioner had moved the representations to the police officials and referred to the representation dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) given to respondent No.3- Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, and respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-7). He contends that no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Adesh Pal Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, will consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with law.

5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-7) in

accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
