SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 108 dated 31.08.2023 registered under Sections 295-A IPC at P.S. Division No. E, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, Punjab as well as the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned Senior Counsel for respondent No.2 submits that he has instructions to say that the complainant will not pursue the prosecution of the petitioners in these FIRs further and will facilitate cancellation of the FIR or will file the quashing of the FIRs on the basis of the settlement arrived at since the petitioners have tendered unconditionally apology to the complainant.



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In light of the above, nothing survives in the present petition, therefore, counsel for the petitioner do not wish to press this petition on merits and seeks withdrawal of the same at this stage.

The petition is therefore, disposed of having been not pressed, however, the petitioner would be at liberty to file afresh on the same cause of action if the complainant-respondent No.2 do not adhere to the statement made before this Court.
