Main case

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.45, dated 12.05.2024, under Sections 341,323, 506,148,149,307 of IPC (Section 308 and 325 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Arniwala, District

Fazilka (Annexure P-1).
