1. Petitioners Roopa Rani and Mahinder Singh have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents to protect life and personal liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.
2. Learned counsel representing State has placed on record statements of Roopa Rani and Mahinder Singh petitioners recorded by the police, according to which, there is no threat perception to the petitioners.
