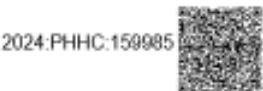

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.109 dated 03.09.2022, registered under Sections 420, 506 of IPC and Sections 89, 99, 92 of Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016, at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 24.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has paid a sum of Rs.35 lacs to Udham Singh, complainant and Rs.8,50,000/- to Pankaj Dhawan.

3. Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent also submits that he has received a sum of Rs.35,00,000/-.

4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.11.2024, passed



by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

6. Pending application stands also disposed of.
