SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who is in custody since 14.04.2024 and is facing trial for offence of murder in FIR No. 215 dated 13.04.2024 under Sections 302, 34 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Old Industrial Panipat, District Panipat, has filed this petition for grant of regular bail.

2. It is informed that charge-sheet has been filed on 02.07.2024 and the charges have been framed on 15.10.2024. However, not even a single prosecution witness has been examined till date.

3. Affording an opportunity to the prosecution to examine the main witnesses, this Court, for the time being, declines bail to the petitioner on the ground of gravity of offence.

4. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court for grant of bail, after main prosecution



witnesses are examined before the trial court or if the trial gets delayed, whichever is earlier.
