In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that despite the fact that the petitioner was allowed to continue in service upto the age of 60 years but, again the similar order has been passed, which is arbitrary and illegal and in fact amounts to contempt of Court as the respondents had given a statement before this Court so as to allow the petitioner to continue in service.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun Gupta, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that keeping in view of the Instructions received from Mr. Gulbhar Singh, Deputy Director, Social Security and Women and Child Development, Punjab, the impugned order dated

22.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order in accordance with law

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) has already been withdrawn hence, the petitioner will be allowed to continue in service without interruption hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
