JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of standing order No.6 of 2021 (Annexure P-1) and advertisement dated 09.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the extent there is no provision for waiting list.
2. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, at the outset, submits that petitioners have secured substantially lesser marks than last selected candidate. By impugned advertisement, applications were invited for 6 domains and each domain comprised of multiple specializations. On account of multiple domains, there was no possibility of waiting list. In any case, the marks secured by petitioners are substantially lesser than last selected candidate, thus, they cannot be considered.
3. Faced with this, Mr. Suvir Sidhu, Advocate for the petitioners submits that respondent has not supplied result of petitioners as well as other selected candidates, thus, claim of respondent cannot be countenanced.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab submits that result is available on the website, thus, claim of petitioners is not sustainable.
5. The respondent is directed to upload, if not uploaded, final result of all the selected candidates on its website.
5. From the perusal of result of petitioners as produced during the course of hearing, it comes out that they have secured substantially lesser marks than last selected candidate, thus, they are not eligible for the post claimed. The petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application, if averments of respondent, at any stage, are found incorrect.
6. Disposed of.
