1. On 30.11.2023, the following order was passed:

“This petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*mandamus*' directing the official respondents No. 1 to 3-State for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 8 and not to allow the private respondents to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

*Inter alia* contends that the petitioner is a major though living with her parents and her parents wanted to marry the petitioner with the person of their choice which is not acceptable to the petitioner, as such, she had called police helpline number on 12.10.2023 and in response to the said call, Sube Singh, incharge of Police Station Sadar, District Ambala, called her, as well as her family members to the police station but thereafter, the custody of the petitioner was handed over back to her parents without redressal of her grievance and even her mobile phone was takenback.

Having received advance copy of the petition, Mr. Kirpal Singh Thakur, A.A.G., Haryana, appears on behalf of official respondents No. 1 to 3-State seeks time to submit a status report in respect of the aforesaid allegations and further submitted that the petitioner has not filed any representation.

Adjourned to 22.01.2024.

In the meanwhile, status report be filed.

The present petition be treated as a representation.”

2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Deepak Kumar Jewaria, IPS,

Assistant Superintendent of Police, Ambala, District Ambala has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel contends that as per status report, the inquiry was conducted on the allegations of the petitioner-complainant that her father, brother and uncle used to beat her and she was also having the apprehension that they would commit her murder. Thereafter, during the inquiry, the petitioner-complainant and her family members have effected a compromise. The family members of the petitioner-complainant have apologized. The petitioner-complainant stated that she wants to live with her parents. Statement of the petitioner-complainant is annexed as Annexure R-1 and statements of respondents No.4 to 7 are annexed as Annexures R-2 to R-4. He submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of accordingly .
4. The present petition is disposed of in view of the aforesaid terms.
5. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
