The present appeal is directed against order dated 04.11.2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat, whereby bail application filed by the appellant in case arising out of FIR No.417 dated 27.10.2023 under Section 306 IPC and Section 3(2) (Va) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat, has been dismissed.

Learned Counsel for the appellant submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.02.2024 passed by this Court, the appellant has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the appellant has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 13.02.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.02.2024 is made absolute.

However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The present appeal stands disposed of.
