The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.184 dated 22.06.2023 registered under Sections 379 IPC at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 15.11.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.
