1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the whimsical action of the respondent-Commission, whereby during course of recruitment process, while filling up the posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officer (Group-B) in AYUSH Department, the well qualified and eligible candidates have been disqualified, without assigning any cogent reason of their purported disqualification.
2. Learned counsel would submit that regarding the claim raised in the present petition, representations dated 14.10.2024 and 18.10.2024 have been submitted by the petitioner, which have yet not evoked any response. He, thus, at this stage, on instructions, prays that a direction be given to the respondent to decide the same in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurnoor Sandhu, Advocate

accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

5. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent to decide the representations dated 14.10.2024 and 18.10.2024, expeditiously, in accordance with law.
