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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners, who claim themselves to be the residents of Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana, have made various representations dated 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-5), 07.09.2024 (Annexure P-6) and 03.10.2024 (Annexure P-7) to different authorities objecting to the construction of Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP) at Leisure Valley, Ludhiana by contending that the residents of the area were not consulted in terms of the State Treated Waste Water Policy, 2017 (Annexure P-3).



2. Instead of keeping this petition pending, it would be appropriate to direct the concerned authorities to look into the grievance of the petitioners while deciding the aforesaid representations.
3. Let respondent No. 3 – Municipal Commissioner, Ludhiana look into the aforesaid representations made by the petitioners and pass a speaking order as expeditiously as possible.
4. This Court hastens to add that no comments on merits of the petition have been made and the respondent No. 3 is free to decide the matter either way.
5. The petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.
