1. Status report has been filed by respondent-State. The same is taken on record. Be tagged at the appropriate place. It is submitted therein as well as by learned State counsel that initially the petitioner was reluctant to take his mobile phones back but the same have been returned to him and DDR No.21 dated 03.03.2024 has also been entered in the concerned Police Station in this regard.
