SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

The jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been invoked for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus seeking direction to official respondents No.2 & 3 to get released the detainee namely Muskan, aged about 15 years 8 months, daughter of the petitioner, from the illegal custody of private respondent.

On the last date of hearing, learned State Counsel would submit that the alleged detainee namely Muskan is placed at Sikandrabad and sought seven days time to produce her.

Today, the alleged detainee-Muskan is produced by HC Dalvir Kaur and learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the alleged detainee Muskan was recovered from Gopal Nagar, Sikandrabad, Telangana and in this regard FIR No. 315 dated 11/10/2024 registered at P.S. Dera Bassi, Mohali has been lodged



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against the boy who has now been arrested. He further confirms the handing over the alleged detainee, Muskan to his father namely Bablu Sharma-the present petitioner who is present in the Court accompanied by his counsel. In this regard, statements of alleged detainee namely Muskan and his father-the present petitioner have been recorded separately which are taken on record.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition, hence, the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the police would be at liberty to proceed in the FIR mentioned above in accordance with law.
