The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 of The Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, has been invoked seeking the concession for the
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0135 dated 21.08.2024, under
Section 420 of IPC, 1860 and Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983 registered at
Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 06.11.2024, while issuing notice of
motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his
joining the investigation and an undertaking given by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner is ready and willing to pay the amount of Rs.50,000/-
to the complainant.

In compliance to the order dated 06.11.2024, a payment of Rs.
50,000/- has been made to the complainant today, who is present in Court and has

acknowledged receiving the stated amount. The complainant has been identified by ASI Subhash Chand.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 06.11.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and on instructions from ASI Subhash Chand further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 06.11.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
