1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioners on the higher side at par with the same grade officers in the other establishments and in the Government.
2. None had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners on previous two consecutive dates of hearing i.e. 14.12.2022 and 01.05.2023. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.
3. It appears that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present petition. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
