[2] Learned counsel for respondent No. 3 points out that in an intra-Court appeal, preferred by The Sonipat Cooperative Sugar Mill Ltd., Sonipat, order dated 25.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Writ Court in

CWP-6388-2016 has been stayed vide order dated 27.11.2024 passed by the Hon’ble Division Bench in *CM-7167-LPA-2024 in/and LPA-2924-2024*, titled “*The Sonipat Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd. Sonipat Versus Dalbir and others*”.

[3] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition at this stage with liberty to seek revival, if required, subject to final outcome of the intra-Court appeal.
