The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.51 dated 15.06.2023 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 17.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 17.11.2023 is made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
