The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner, as respondent No.7 had moved certain false, mischievous and motivated complaints against the petitioner before different police authorities.
2. Learned State counsel submits that one FIR No. 86 dated 31.10.2020 under Section 420,465,467,468,471,406,409,120-B of IPC Police Station Sadar Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar has been registered against the petitioner. Learned State counsel further submits that an enquiry has been carried out by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Nawanshahar with regard to the allegations levelled by the present petitioner.

He had not sought any security from the State as he has already having a licensed firearm for his protection. Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner has been instructed to approach the SHO Police Sation City Nawanshahar, Control Room Nawanshahar or any other officer telephonically in case of any exigency. Further, SHO Police Station City, Nawanshahar has already been directed to carry out random patrolling around the residence/ hospital of the petitioner. He further contends that in fact, if any representation is received from the petitioner, appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
