1. The present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 20.10.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860 and Section 326 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Patara, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar Rural.

2. Vide order dated 21.11.2023, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

4. In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 21.11.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the

It is made clear that, in case, the petitioner is found involved in any such activity once again, the State is at liberty to promptly move an appropriate application for cancellation of bail detailing out the circumstances and violation of the condition(s) of bail.
