Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Harsimran Singh Bal, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City-II), District SAS Nagar, along with Annexures R-1/T and R-2/T has been filed on behalf of respondent-State. Para No.5 of the status report is relevant, which reads as under:-

“That keeping in view the allegations levelled in the present petition filed by the petitioners and the prayer made for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and their associates, the petitioner Daljit Singh and Jasveer Kaur were summoned and the statement of Daljit Singh and Jasveer Kaur wherein, he got recorded that he and his family members do not want any police security with regard to the present petition filed by them as he and his family members have amicably compromised the dispute and also produced a copy of the compromise. The true translated copy of the statement of Daljit Singh and Compromise Deed are attached herewith as Annexure R-1/T and Annexure R-2/T respectively for the kind consideration of this Hon’ble Court.”
