1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-15791-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-15791-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 18.01.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 18.01.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority.
