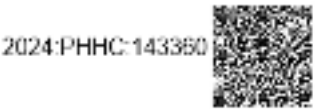
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SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Cr. PC, seeking quashing of the order dated 14.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, in complaint No. NACT No. 422 dated 02.07.2016, titled as '*Amarjit Singh vs. Rajiv Kashyap*', whereby the present petitioner had been declared as proclaimed person.

2. Heard.

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3. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant, aforesaid complaint, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar has been withdrawn, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 2 has not disputed the aforesaid fact and has also produced a photocopy of the order dated 20.09.2024 passed by the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, to this effect, the same is taken on record and marked as Annexure ‘A’.

5. Since the complaint in which the petitioner had been summoned already stood withdrawn vide order dated 20.09.2024 (*supra*), instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous.
