A short reply dated 15.01.2024 by way of an affidavit of Kanwalpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar-Rural has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.

On 20.11.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.199 dated 21.12.2021 under Sections 307, 379-B(2), 148 and 149 IPC as well as under Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner had been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. as he was found innocent during the investigation. He further contends that a compromised had been effected between the parties.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ramta K Chaudhary, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. She

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prays for sometime to file a reply. On her request, adjourned to 15.01.2024.

Let a reply on behalf of the respondent-State be filed well in time before the next date of hearing with a copy in advance to the counsel opposite.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned and on his doing so, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing necessary bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

In view of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, the aforementioned order is made absolute.
