MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.140 dated 03.08.2023 registered under Sections 447/506/323/354/148/149 and 325 (added later on) IPC, 1860 and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

2. Vide order dated 11.12.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.12.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
