MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.73 dated 13.07.2020, under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa.

(2) This Court, on 10.01.2024, granted interim bail to petitioner and the order reads as under:-

“Contends that petitioner was declared innocent by the police during investigation and he has been summoned under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C; thus, his custodial interrogation would not be required at this stage.

Learned State counsel seeks time to have instructions in the matter.

Posted for 26.02.2024.

In the meanwhile, petitioner(s) shall surrender before learned trial Court within 01 (one) week from today. Upon

doing so, he be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned.”

- (3) Learned counsel submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has already joined the proceedings before learned trial Court and he shall fully cooperate in future.
- (4) Learned State Counsel, on instructions, acknowledged that petitioner has joined the proceedings and as on today, his custody is not required.
- (5) In view of above, interim order dated 10.01.2024 is made absolute as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
- (6) It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and shall not seek unnecessary adjournments.
- (7) The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case; rather confined only to decide the present bail matter.
- (8) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
