1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.126 dated 21.06.2023 registered under Sections 420, 506, 120-B and 34 of IPC at Police Station New Colony District Gurugram.
2. The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner and his co-accused had taken money worth Rs. 3.35 lacs from complainant by giving him false assurance to get the petitioner selected in HCS examination. Out of the aforesaid amount of Rs. 3.35 lacs the accused persons returned Rs. 1.5 lacs to the complainant.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order the petitioner deposited Rs. 50,000/-

with the Court concerned and also joined the investigation with the police.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajender, has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He further submits that petitioner is not required for any further investigation in the present case by the police.

5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 24.01.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as are envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
