This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 29.08.2023 passed in CWP-18939-2023.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed by learned counsel for the respondent today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 29.08.2023 passed in CWP-18939-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 29.11.2023 has been passed.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
