1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for quashing of an undated status report (Annexure P-7), in case FIR No.84, dated 29.04.2017, registered under Section 420 of the IPC, at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, District Patiala.

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that after conducting the investigation, in the instant FIR, the investigating agency of District Patiala, has concluded that in fact the offence has not been committed within the jurisdiction of District Patiala, rather, it was committed within the territorial jurisdiction of the UT, Chandigarh. Therefore, investigating agency of District Patiala, has filed a cancellation report, which was not accepted by the magistrate concerned

and vide order dated 04.08.2018 (Annexure R-1), the magistrate concerned, has directed to carry out further investigation through a competent officer.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by SI Gurmeet Singh, submits that in compliance to the aforesaid direction issued, vide order dated (*supra*), further investigation is being carried out, and very soon the investigation will be concluded, and final report will be submitted before the magistrate concerned, within a month from today.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement, suffered by learned State counsel, no further direction is required to be passed by this Court in the instant petition, at this stage.

5. Therefore, the instant petition is **disposed of**, accordingly.
