1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to issue directions to respondent No.2 to give police clearance Certificate to the petitioner in view of an untrace report dated 30.07.2009 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, the untrace report has already been accepted on 13.03.2024 by the competent Court and no matter is pending with the police. Consequently, the petitioner may apply for clearance Certificate before the concerned authority, in accordance with law. He further assured the Court that in case, any application is received from the petitioner in this regard, the same shall be disposed of within a period of 04 weeks, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly disposed of.
4. Pending application, if any, stand(s), disposed of, accordingly.
